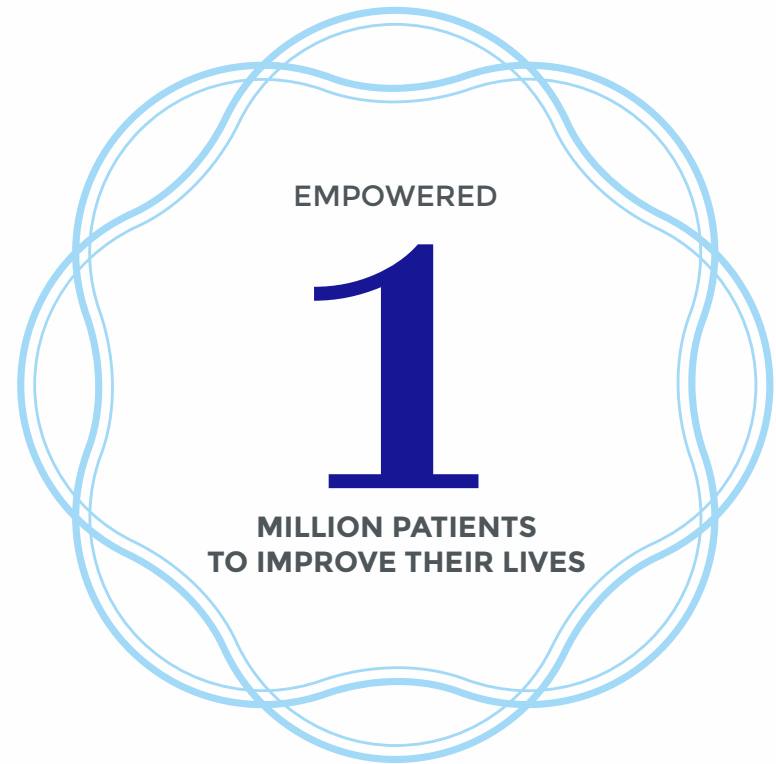

Institutions, corporates, entrepreneurs, promoters of various companies, bankers, philanthropists and prominent families of Gujarat readily responded to the clarion call of Shri Pravinbhai Laheri, Dr. Pankaj Shah, Shri Prashant Kinarivala and Shri Kshitish Madanmohan and donated to the cause. Amongst the major donors were Shri Arvind Narottam, Shri Chintan Parikh, Shri Gautambhai Adani, Shri Ratibhai Kamdar, Vaipa pharmaceuticals, Subra Trading Pvt Ltd., Great Equipment Leasing co. Pvt Ltd., Safal Developers, Bharat Kshatriya and Samaria Parivar, Ajit Mehta (Infinium Toyota) Yugesh, Niraj, Sharvi Shah (Bhoomi Textiles), Shri Shekhar Patel (Ganesh Housing), Zaveri and Co. (Rajkotvala), Shri Girishbhai Naranbhai Patel (Sterling Hospitals), Shri Utkarsh B. Shah of Jito, Shri Bhadrash Shah of AIA Engineering, Shri Prakash Bhagvati and Shri Pravinbhai Bhagvati, The State Bank Of India, prominent industrialist families like the Wagh Bakri, Bidiwala, Kinariwala and Madanmohan Ramanlal, Smt. Nandiniben Munshaw, The Kalupur Bank, ADC Bank, Textile Traders Bank and many others readily embraced the cause.

With the 'healthcare spectrum' being close to my heart I too readily supported the cause at both a personal and enterprise level.

Besides funding the project personally, the Zydus group also backed the cause and has been one of the major contributors to GCSMCH making it a part of its CSR initiatives.

There were several inspired ideas explored for funding the cause. Shri Girishbhai Dani and Karnavati club Ltd. organized a discourse by the renowned seer Shri Morari Bapu to raise funds. We were also transported back in time when the leading ladies of industrial families of Ahmedabad, came together to contribute to the cause much in the same way when they had come together in 1960 to set up the Gujarat Cancer Society. Smt Nandiniben Munshaw, Smt Yaminiben Hemchand, Smt Lalluben Daruwala, Smt Manoramaben Munshaw, Smt Naliniben Subodhbhai and Smt Kokilaben Jagdishbhai, led the way with their generosity of spirit. With these herculean efforts of co-creation, the entire project was completed within two years. In 2011, the then Chief Minister of Gujarat, Hon'ble Shri Narendra Modi, inaugurated this unique private-public partnership venture and dedicated it to the people of Gujarat.

That's how the GCS Medical College, Hospital and Research Centre (GCSMCH) came into being. The little spark is now a glowing beacon of light, shining bright and serving the needs of the society.

GCSMCH has been at the forefront, providing healthcare to the underprivileged sections of the society at its Multispecialty Hospital. Each day, more than 1500 outpatients are taken care of at the hospital and nearly 4.5 lac patients receive treatment every year. With nearly 20 super-specialty areas being offered, patients walk into GCSMCH with the hope and confidence of receiving the best-in-class treatment. The GCS Medical College, as envisioned, has also been producing MBBS graduates of high caliber, who have been the top rankers in the State. In 2017, GCSMCH started offering postgraduate courses in medicine. At every step of the way, the team of doctors, faculty and staff of GCSMCH have contributed to the growth and progress of this institution with their courage, determination and relentless pursuit of excellence. I am indeed grateful to them and the Dean, Dr.Kirtibhai Patel for his contributions to this project from the start.

Shah Cancer Hospital, Civil Hospital Compound, Ahmedabad and Community Oncology Centre (COC), Vasna. Lacs of patients have been diagnosed and treated till date.

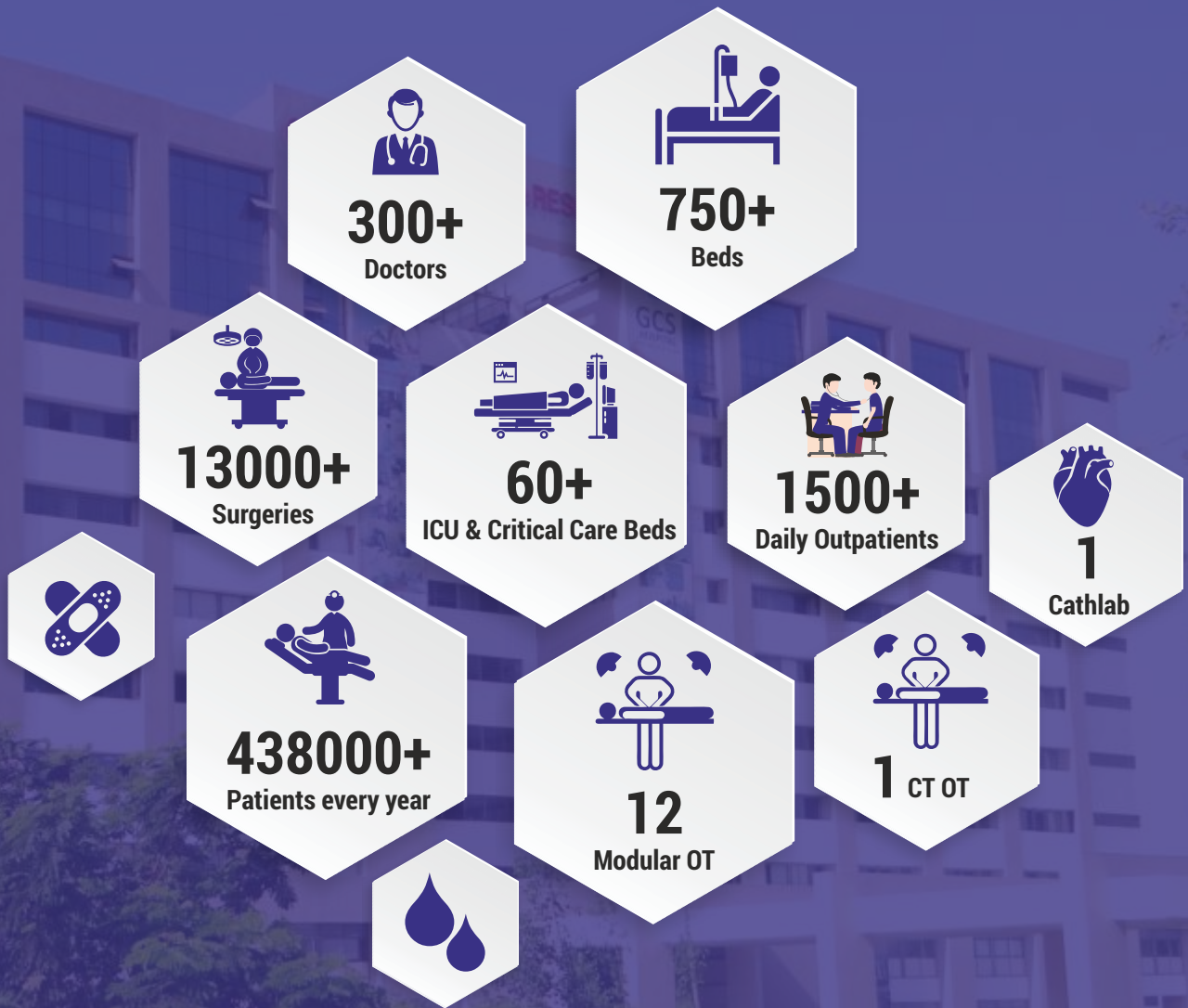

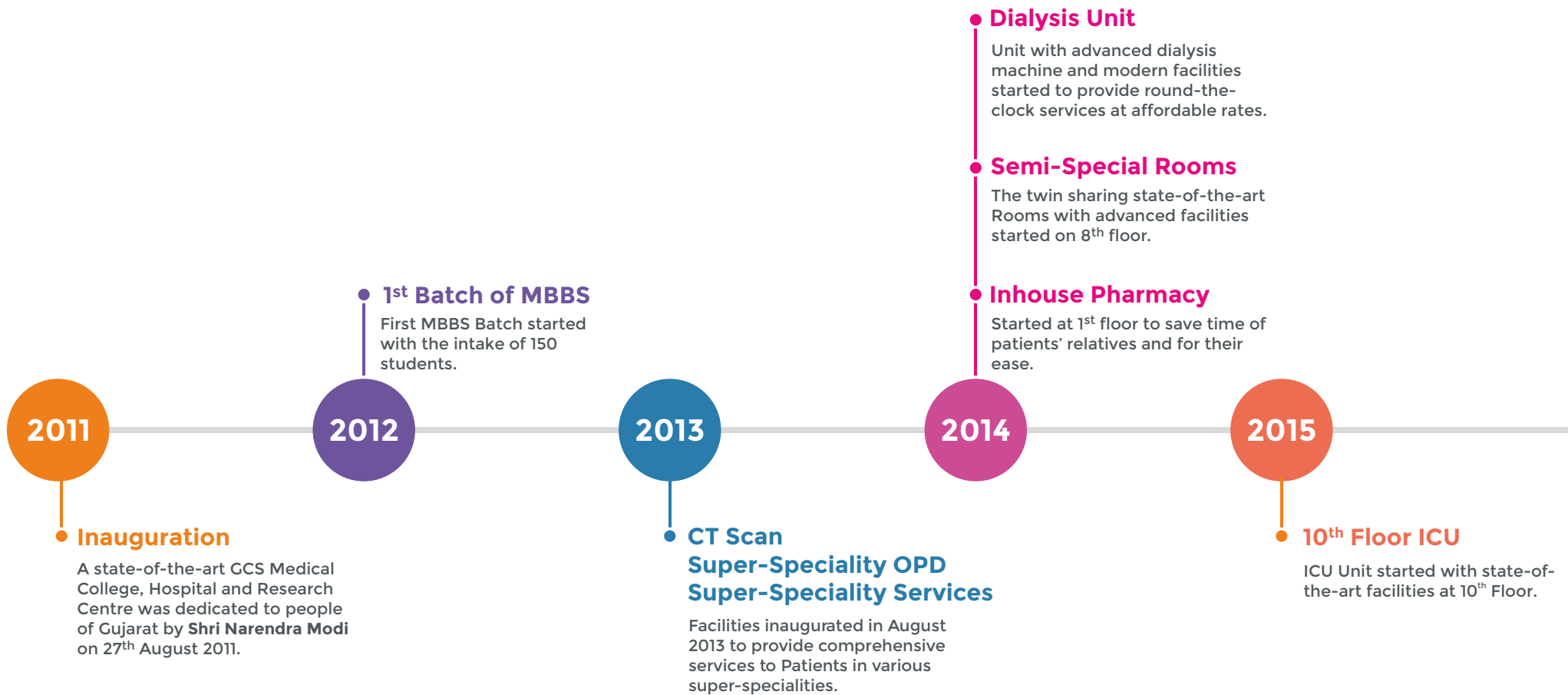


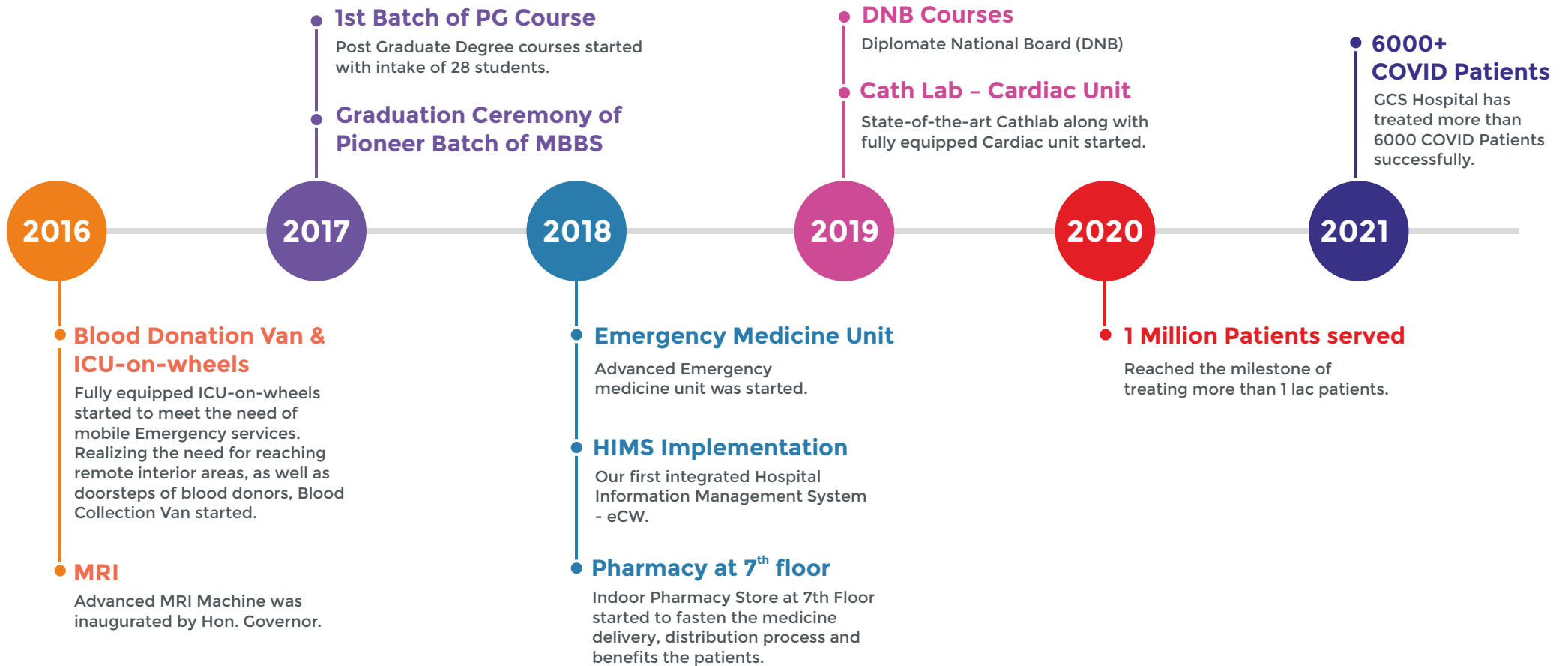


About GCS Medical College
